Killer Kane looks ready to lift Trophy at favourite course

Killer Kane has a good record at Kempton Park and can gain the biggest success of his career there today in the Coral Trophy Handicap Chase (3.37).

Two of his three wins over fences have come over this course and distance and he again ran well here when third to Highstakesplayer 15 days ago. That was his first start since having an operation to help with his breathing and, with that outing behind him, Killer Kane should be ready to show his best. He looks a fair bet at the 12-1 offered by Coral and Ladbrokes.

Useful Flat performer Peking Opera made a winning start over jumps at Sandown Park and he can follow up in the Coral Adonis Juvenile Hurdle (1.50). He finished fourth in the Irish Derby last year when trained by Aidan O'Brien being sold for 100,000

guineas (£105,000) and moving to the yard of Gary Moore. He looked a natural when winning at Sandown, jumping fluently, and looks the type to take high rank in this sphere.

The Coral Pencil Novices' Chase (2.27) can go to Blow Your Wad. He made a good start over fences when second to Le Patron — who reopposes on 17lb worse terms — at Sandown before scoring over this course and distance. He lost a shoe when a below-par sixth in a competitive race at Cheltenham last time and, under conditions that suit, can bounce back to form.

Lump Sum appears in the Coral Dovecot Novices' Hurdle (3.00). Fair in bumpers last term, he has improved since switching to hurdles, winning his first two starts before a good second to Jeriko Du Reponet in grade two company at Doncaster. He shaped better than the result suggests there, held up in a slowly-run race and still last jump-

ing two out before staying on strongly. The front-running Panjari should ensure that this is a more truly-run contest and Lump Sum will be tough to beat.

Stamina will be the key to the BettingBet Eider Handicap Chase (2.08) at Newcastle, which will be run over an extended four miles on testing ground. Anglers Crag looks the one to beat. He has improved since joining trainer Brian Ellison this season, winning all three starts, and his breeding suggests that he will be even more effective now that he tackles a marathon test.

At Southwell, Eydon can land the BetUK Winter Derby (3.20). He looked promising two years ago but has not been seen since finishing fourth in the 2,000 Guineas in 2022. Andrew Balding, his trainer, has made a fast start to the year with 17 winners already on the board and Eydon, who should relish this step up in trip, can add to his tally.

This handicap has been a poor race for favourite backers, with Gungadu (2008) the latest to prevail. Sam Twiston-Davies, with three wins, is the most successful present jockey in this race. He rides Blackjack Magic today

Banker or bust? Moon Chime (1.05 Newcastle)

Unbeaten in two starts in bumpers, he opened his account over hurdles in good style at Huntingdon last time. He is the form pick here and, likely to improve over this longer trip, looks difficult to oppose. BANKER

Red-hot trainer Charlie Appleby

Godolphin's trainer has his Newmarket yard in flying form, with six winners from his past eight runners in Britain. His only entry today is Military Order (3.20) at Southwell

Repeat performance? Lord North (3.20 Southwell)

He easily landed this prize when it was staged at Lingfield 12 months ago. This four-time group one winner is clearly the class act in the race but is now an eight-year-old and could be vulnerable to a less-exposed rival

What's in a name? Guy Fawkes (7.20 Chelmsford)

He is a son of the stallion Harry Angel but owes his name to his dam, Fire Blaze. A half-brother to Tinderbox, he looked red-hot when winning on his debut but proved a damp squib at Chelmsford last time

Bet of the day Lump Sum (3.00 Kempton Park)

Unsuited by a slow early pace when losing his unbeaten record over hurdles at Doncaster last month. Should have conditions to suit here and can regain the winning thread

Russian qualifier earns place in Dubai final by sweeping aside Swiatek and Gauff

Tennis The Russian qualifier Anna Kalinskaya continued her giant-killing run at the Dubai Tennis Championships by stunning the world No1 Iga Swiatek 6-4, 6-4 yesterday to reach the final.

Standing in Kalinskaya's way today will be Jasmine Paolini, who saved six set points in the other semi-final, against the Romanian Sorana Cirstea, to win 6-2, 7-6 (9-6).

Kalinskaya, who had stunned the US Open champion Coco Gauff in the previous round, fought from a break and 4-2 down in the first set, forcing Swiatek into a number of errors. She then broke in the second set as the Pole continued to falter.

At the Qatar Open, the Czech teenager Jakub Mensik became the youngest ATP finalist since Carlos Alcaraz three years ago with a win

against Gaël Monfils in Doha. Mensik, 18, followed up his quarter-final victory over Andrey Rublev, the top seed, by seeing off the 37-year-old Monfils 6-4, 1-6, 6-3.

Mensik, who will rise from 116 in the world to inside the top 100 next week, plays Karen Khachanov in today's final. Khachanov, the second seed, defeated Alexei Popyrin 7-6 (14-12), 6-2 in the other semi-final.

Wigan seek prestigious World Club Challenge history

Rugby league Wigan Warriors will join Sydney Roosters as five-times winners of the World Club Challenge if they beat Penrith Panthers at the DW Stadium today. The Australian side will be driven by the hurt of a year ago when a golden-point drop-goal for St Helens condemned them to defeat in the global showdown.

Kruise Leeming is named in Wigan's 21-player squad despite

sustaining an ankle knock in their Super League round-one win against Castleford Tigers. Luke Thompson misses out having failed a head-injury assessment in last week's victory, with the academy graduate Harvie Hill likely to take his place.

"Last year was a very disappointing loss for them," Adam Keighran, the Wigan centre, said. "They'll be more hungry to set things straight."
